Johan du Plessis, hulpwerker van Arbeidsbediening in die Paarl getuig: “Wat ’n voorreg om met julle te kan deel wat die Here vir een van ons besoekpunte, die MCM (Monte Christo Miqlat)-groep, gedoen het. Die koortjiedigter sê: ‘Die liefde van Jesus is wonderbaar!’ Daarop sê ons ‘Amen!’”

Johan verduidelik: “Vir byna twee jaar kom ons Vrydagoggende by die taxi-staanplek langs die Bergrivier bymekaar vir ons bediening aan die MCM-groep. Ons het geen ander plek gehad as om op ’n verkeerseilandjie bymekaar te kon kom met taxi’s wat gedurigdeur verby ons jaag nie.

“Die geraas was meestal so erg dat ons nie mekaar kon hoor nie. Sommige se skel-/vloektaal was aan die orde van die dag. Ons was blootgestel aan die wind en weer en soms moes ons die byeenkoms as gevolg daarvan afstel.

“Ons het toe vir die Here gebid vir ’n onderdakplekkie, mét stoele. En ons Vader het ons gebede beantwoord!

“Ons Burgemeester, die Hoof Uitvoerende Beampste van HG Molenaar & Co (Pty) Ltd, asook verskeie ander personeel van MCM het ’n nuwe dubbele skeepsvragehouer (geborg deur Isipani) wat op ’n sementblad op die wal van die Bergrivier opgerig is, met swier geopen. Dit was ’n grootse gebeurtenis vir ons hier by Arbeidsbediening; ons kon nou in ’n menswaardige plek die mense van MCM bedien met God se Woord.

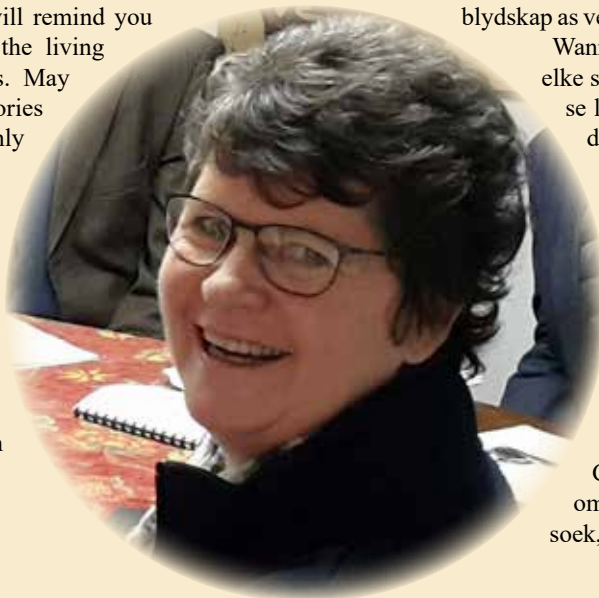


EDITORIAL

Biblia's support for those abused and injured at sea

Dane du Plessis, pastoral worker at Biblia Cape Town, often fights for the rights of abused seafarers. In October last year he had to stand up for their rights once again.

"After Biblia conducted an inspection on a vessel, two Tanzanian fishermen reported to Dane that they had been beaten by the Chinese captain who happens not to be fond of African people. They were the only Africans in a crew of about twenty.

"The rest of the crew (Indonesians and Filipinos) testified that the two were indeed being abused, whereafter the captain reluctantly admitted that he was guilty, 'only a little smack on their heads a few times...'

Dane continues, "After negotiations with the shipping owners and agents, the two men were finally sent home and compensated accordingly.

"A few days later I was sent a picture by one of the men, posing at the airport with his wife and sister. He reported that he was safe and extremely grateful for the help Biblia had given him; he would never forget what Biblia had done for him."

Dane shared a second story of how Biblia supports seafarers, "Eric began working on a South African trawler in mid 2018. Knowing that his wife was pregnant, it was the only means of income for the family and his soon-to-be-born son.

"While at sea between Cape Town and St Helena, a heavy metal object fell on Eric's left foot. Unfortunately, being out on the ocean often means lack of access to adequate medical care. Eric waited nearly a day to reach Cape Town and despite his wounds finally being treated, he still lost three toes.

"Currently Biblia is working alongside the AOS (Apostleship of the Sea (<http://bit.ly/2VULTSF>) in Cape Town to ensure that Eric is compensated for the loss of his toes and fighting for the company to be held liable for all medical bills and outstanding

wages. Eric is recovering at home and his son has since been born. He hopes to make a career change and be an Uber driver in the future."

Ceres se seën en waardering

Alle geestelike werkers en bedienaars van God's Woord sal seker saamstem dat mens dit soms baie nodig het om ook deur iemand anders geestelik bedien te word. So het dit ook hierdie jaar op Ceres gebeur.

Willie Smit, geestelike werker op Ceres, deel met ons hoe hy vanjaar uit 'n onverwagte oord geseën is: "Terwyl ek vroeër vanjaar op pad na Ceres toe was, sien ek iemand langs die pad duimgooi en besluit om hom 'n saamrygeleentheid te gee. Dit was kort na Paasfees. Omdat ek gewoonnd daaraan is om met baie verskillende soorte mense te gesels, was dit ook vir my maklik om ons gesprek in 'n geestelike rigting te stuur. En daar bemoedig en bedien hierdie ryloper my toe so wonderlik deur sy getuienis! Hy vertel aan my hoe wonderlik en geseënd hy die Paasfees ervaar het en hoe hy weer opnuut onder die indruk van die krag van Christus se Gees gekom het – dat 'n mens alle mense moet liefhê en nederig moet wees. Dit het my baie diep geraak en net weer eens laat besef hoe liefdevol die Gees van die Here is."

Soms is dit ook goed om te hoor as die mense aan wie jy bedien jou waardeer. Een van die ander vrywilligers van Arbeidsbediening daar, deel met ons die reaksie van die mense wat sy bedien by van haar besoekpunte: "Dit is wonderlik toe een van die vroue na 'n diens vir my 'n drukkie kom gee het omdat my woorde haar 'so diep geraak' het.

"En dan is dit wonderlik om gereeld tegemoet gekom te word deur twee of drie vroue, as hulle my deur die winkelvenster sien aankom en die deur met oop arms en breë glimlagge kom oopmaak!

"'n Bestuurderes van een van die ondernemings waar ons bedien, het ook al getuig dat elke keer as ek daar kom, dit vir haar voel asof my boodskap spesiaal vir haar was. Dit beteken vir haar geweldig baie en dit gee vir haar die krag wat sy nodig het vir die maand – tot ek weer die volgende maand kom."

Support initiatives that restore those in need

At IMPAK, Industrial Ministry's local action committee branch, our purpose is not only to reach people in the workplace with the Word of God, but also to support initiatives that restore those who need help in other areas of life.

IMSA's ministry facilitator, Jaco Leeuwner, took a step closer to the marketplace in this regard when he recently accepted the position as branch manager for MES (Mould Empower Serve) Cape Town. MES provides 45 men and 18 women with a place to sleep every night at their Safe Space accommodation unit in Bellville.

Men and women who would have had no other option than to sleep on the street, are now offered a second chance in life through MES's GROW (God Restoring Our World) programme. Here participants are rehabilitated and coached to re-enter the normal working world.

Over a period of 9 to 12 months they have free access to professional services such as welfare and occupational therapy as well as the opportunity to earn a small income under close supervision.

MES with its Safe Space accommodation and GROW programme can be duplicated anywhere and is fully outcome-based, equipping down-and-out members of society to safely exit and enter back into working life.

IMPAK is excited about finding creative ways of working alongside MES at their GROW depots in Bellville, Durbanville and Brackenfell.

A small grey building called the BIBLIA kiosk at the Kalk Bay Harbour entrance offers the destitute and needy a safe, cosy space in which to experience the love of Christ through prayer support or even just a hot cup of coffee.

The appreciation of the community echoes through the recent words of a local fisherman, "The fishing community would be lost without Pastor Marvin."

Marvin shares the following inspiring story, "When we recently went to Home Affairs in Wynberg, a lady came out of the U-Turn clothing shop calling, 'Pastor, Pastor!'"

"At first we didn't recognize her but then she said, 'It's me, Bianca'. We were dumbstruck, amazed and encouraged to see her doing so well.

Marvin explains, "We hadn't seen her and her partner for more than two and a half years, but before they disappeared Bianca and her partner, both homeless at the time, had been coming to our ministry regularly, faithfully sitting under the teaching of God's Word. They heard the gospel and benefited from food parcels. The couple took our counsel seriously and trusted in the Lord for a changed life. Bianca is now 3 years off drugs, married to her partner and working at the U-Turn shop. They are currently renting a place and most importantly, serving the Lord together.

"What a great gift to see the outcome of a changed life! Bianca couldn't stop thanking us, promising to visit us and to continue testifying to others that with God nothing is impossible.

"This beautiful encounter came by surprise and encouraged us to rest assured that even if we do not always see the fruit of our labour, we may know that we have sown seeds and that God will use this to change people's lives.

"Someone once asked me what successful evangelism looks like. Is it measured by the number of converts we see? I pondered over that question a long time but now I can say – successful evangelism is nothing more than sharing the gospel! We sowed the seed, U-Turn watered it and God made it grow.

"All glory and praise to God!"

It is well worth noting that they must walk everywhere they need to be. This often means a 06:30 start if they want to preach at an 08:00 service at one of the ministry points.

Arbeidsbediening George bedien op ’n nuwe manier



Die eerste groep werknemers wat sertifikate vir hulle Finansiële Geletterdheidsprogram ontvang het. Soos ons weet, bly niks dieselfde nie en moet ons onself gedurig aanpas by veranderende omstandighede, en so ook met Arbeidsbediening. As gevolg van nuwe werklikhede in die werksplek, is hulle onlangs genoop om op ’n nuwe manier na die relevansie van hul bediening in die markplek te gaan kyk.

Ds Floors Meyer wat onlangs geëmeriteer het en nou op kontraktbasis voltyds by Arbeidsbediening in George werksaam is, verduidelik: “As die mense vir Jesus kom vra wat Hy eintlik daar doen, antwoord Hy: ‘Ek het gevangenes kom vry maak.’”

“Daar is soveel mense in werksplekke wat voel dat hulle slagoffers is; slagoffers van apartheid, van BBBEE, van hul omstandighede, dat Arbeidsbediening ’n noodsaaklike roeping het om mense hul ware identiteit in Christus te help ontdek;

om bevryding te beleef.”

Behalwe die verkondiging van die evangelie het Arbeidsbediening ook twee ander belangrike behoeftes geïdentifiseer: eerstens dat hulle geestelike werkers geakkrediteerd moet wees (goed toegerus en ondersteun moet word) sodat hul geloofwaardigheid beskerm kan word. Tweedens is dit nodig om ’n personeel-ondersteuningsprogram uit te rol wat die behoeftes van die markplek aanspreek.

Op George gebruik hulle tans vier geakkrediteerde programme daarvoor: die **BrightStar** Lewensvaardighedsontwikkelingsprogram, die **TID (Traumatic Incidence Reduction)**-program en die **First Light on Bright-Star-program**.

Arbeidsbediening het ’n lisensie-ooreenkoms met *Africa Skills Training*

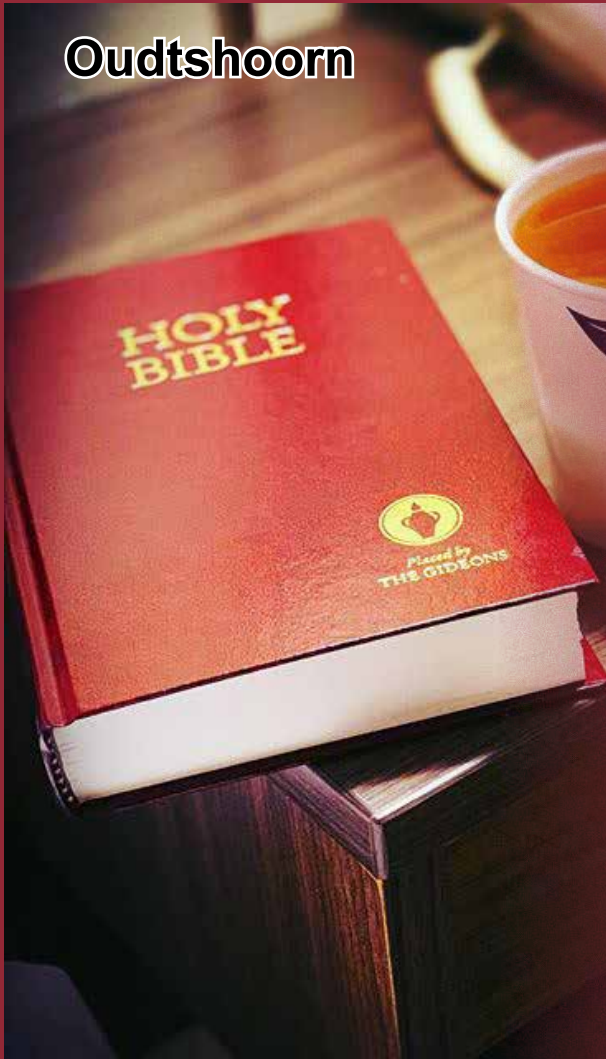
College gesluit om hul **Finansiële Geletterdheidsprogram** aan te bied en gaan ook ’n geakkrediteerde fasiliteerder daar laat oplei. Daar is ’n groot behoefte aan persoonlike finansiële bestuursvaardighede in die markplek.

Die **Dissipelskapsprogram** wat veral in die landbousektor aangebied word, fokus daarop om mense te leer hoe om navolgers van Jesus te wees met die klem op rentmeesterskap. Die vraag is dus nie hoe ’n suksesvolle werkgewer of werknemer ek is nie, maar watter verskil maak ek in mense se lewens?

In George het hulle reeds met hul akkreditasieproses begin en van hierdie passievolle aan-die-brand Plaaslike Aksie-bestuur word daar groot impak verwag.

Oudtshoorn



“Die sleutelwoord is betrokkenheid,” verduidelik André van Staden op navraag hoe Arbeidsbediening dit regkry om sulke goeie verhoudinge met die kerke en instansies op Oudtshoorn te hê.

Arbeidsbediening is baie afhanklik van hul stad of dorp se ondersteuning. Om dit te bewerkstellig, moet werkgewers veral goed verstaan wat die bediening behels en moet daar ook ’n goeie verhouding met kerke en instansies opgebou word.

André en sy vrou het, toe hulle 26 jaar gelede op Oudtshoorn kom woon het, as lede van die Gideons, dadelik by instansies soos kerke, hotelle, hospitale en skole ingeskakel. Hulle het ook op kerkrade gediens en rings- en sinodesittings bygewoon. Toe hulle dus by Arbeidsbediening betrokke raak, was hulle bekend by ’n sterk netwerk van leraars, pastore, besigheidsmanne en skoolhoofde.

Van die ongeveer 80 besoekpunte in Oudtshoorn, besoek André self sowat 40 daarvan. Hy maak ook ekstra tyd om gereeld met die sakemanne en leraars om ’n koppie koffie te kuier.

As gevolg van die positiewe gesindhede wat op hierdie manier opgebou word, word Arbeidsbediening dikwels genooi om tydens erediens te praat en is selfs al versoek om soms dienste waar te neem. Hulle is ook al genooi om op die plaaslike radiostasie op te tree.

Oudtshoorn is nou van voorneme om ook uit te reik na die Chinese in hul midde. Hulle het ’n IAFA (*AVIC International Flying Training Academy*)-vliënskool wat Chinese vlieëniers oplei en sal op hierdie manier met hulle probeer kontak maak. Intussen soek hulle nog iemand wat Mandaryns kan praat, maar sal intussen Mandarynse Bybels aanskaf.

Hulle beplan om vriendskapsbande met hierdie groep mense te bou deur hulle met hul alledaagse probleme by te staan. Dit is belangrik dat die Chinese ’n warm tuiste ver van hul vaderland in Oudtshoorn sal beleef.

Arbeidsbediening beplan om ook ’n bediening aan Oudtshoorn se munisipale straatskoonmakers te begin. André het alreeds by verskeie geleenthede by hulle stilgehou, gesels, saam met hulle gebed en Bybels uitgedeel. Hy voel egter dit moet op ’n wyer vlak plaasvind.

challenged him to call his brother-in-law and confront him about what he is busy with – in the same way that the prophet Nathan had to confront David.

The man later testified that he was no longer afraid and that he did in fact confront his brother-in-law. In the end the brother-in-law was so receptive to discussing the situation that he travelled down to the Cape so that they could talk about the challenges in his life and marriage face-to-face.

Following this, the manager’s wife even phoned her sister and invited her to discuss their marriage with her. Thereafter she flew to her sister where they could talk in depth. It seems as if the couple may now be prepared to give their marriage a second chance.

So, the question is: Am I prepared to influence people’s lives and speak up when I notice that wrong choices are

being made? Or are we silenced by the fear of being hurt or becoming unpopular?

When the Lord lays something on our hearts, He provides the courage, the words, the time and place and He makes the person’s heart receptive to the Spirit. The Lord tells us as He told Joshua: “Be strong and courageous. *Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged*, for the Lord your God will *be* with you wherever you go.”

Because we do not want to see those we care about get hurt, we must do this in an attitude of love, gentleness and humility.

Let us practice caring for and carrying one another here on earth by having an influence in each other’s lives, especially in the workplaces where the Lord has placed us to build His Kingdom.

Jan van den Berg, geestelike werker van Helderberg-Kom, vertel: “Een van ons besighede, Hi-Q (’n motorbandeplek), word deur ons hulpwerker, Willie Foscher, vir die afgelope nege jaar bedien. Die opkoms was nog altyd baie goed en ’n hegte vriendskap het mettertyd tussen die werkers en Willie ontwikkel.

“Willie het die werkers later so goed geken, dat hy kon agterkom as daar iemand was wat nie lekker gevoel of gelyk het nie.

“Een so ’n werker was ’n Xhosa van die Transkei met die naam, Vuyo (wat ‘vreugde’ beteken). Sy gesondheid was swak, hy was baie arm en daar was ’n gebrek aan mediese dienste by sy blyplek. Daarom het hy besluit om as ekstra hand in die Strand by Hi-Q te kom werk. Dit

het hom daartoe in staat gestel om gereeld van sy verdienste na sy familie te kon stuur, aangesien daar geen bron van inkomste by hulle was nie.

“Vuyo het aan Willie vertel dat die godsdiens daar in die Transkei anders is as waarvan Willie hulle hier vertel. In die Transkei speel voorvadergeeste ’n groot rol, maar hy meen dat dit hom niks help nie; hy voel in sy hart dat God met hom praat en dat hy gelukkig en gerus voel as Willie vir hulle die Boodskap bring.

“Eendag het Vuyo vir Willie gevra om saam met hom te bid en so het hy sy hart vir die Here gegee. Vuyo het begin straal en in sy werk kon mense dit ook agterkom. Hy was vriendelik, ywerig, hulpvaardig en geïnspireerd.

“Dit het só ’n indruk op die ander



werkers gemaak, dat hulle na Vuyo gekom het vir voorbidding as hulle probleme gehad het.

“Intussen is Vuyo ongelukkig oorlede, maar die Christelike gesindheid wat hy uitgeleef het, leef steeds voort in hierdie werksplek.”

It's full steam ahead for Train Ministry in communities



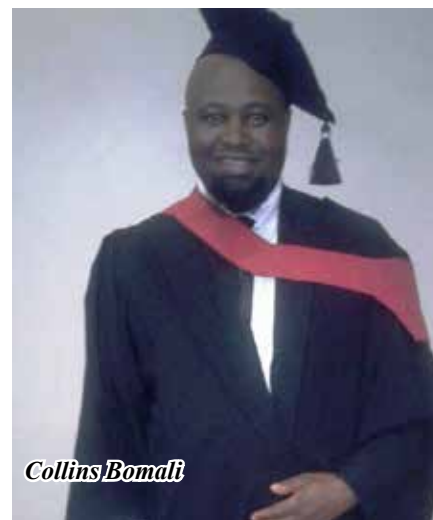
